


What is the Heart of a piece?




Heart **Statement** must contain components






- 1.) The single most important musical element
- 2.) Uses affective language to describe the effect of this element
- 3.) Points to an Outcome



A great Heart Statement:

- Provides the "scent" of the piece and how it might sound
- Is the essence of the piece and what makes it truly tick



Questions to ask as you begin finding the heart

What makes it distinctive ? what EleMENT is at the heart of my piece & what makes it which was maked in the ma

LOVE this piece?

What do I learn about myself through this piece

From yesterday's Analysis Presentation:


The heart of Bach's Arioso is the serene, contemplative melody that reminds us of the impermanent nature of our lives.

The heart of How Can I
Keep from Singing? is its
pentatonic melody which

back to its beginning.


