
GETTING STARTED

- Be responsible. Keep your harmonica in its case and remember where you put it!


BREATHING

HOLDING your HARMONICA




- . The numbers are on top.

- Much of it should be in your mouth like a sandwich!






Single note melodies: Key of C (straight harp) 4 blow is "do"
Major chords (I IV & V): Key of G (cross harp concept)
2/3/4 draw is I chord (G) 4/5/6 blow is IV chord (C)
4/5/6 draw is V chord (D with flat 7 blues sound)
Major chords (I & V7): Key of C
4/5/6 blow is I chord (C) (2)3/4/5 draw is V7 chord (G
Minor chord: D minor is draw 4/5/6 (double cross!)
